

LAPATHON

Students are going to participate in a Lapathon at Woodlands Primary School on Thursday August 17th. Foundation Students will be completing the Lapathon between 9:05 and 10:00am, Years 1 and 2 between 10:00am and 11:00pm, Years 3 and 4 from 11:30 until approximately 12:30pm and Years 5 to 6 will be completing the Lapathon between 12:30pm and 1:30pm. Families are welcome to come along and join their children for a few laps or encourage them as they make their way around the course. During lunchtime you may wish to have a family picnic! Money raised will be put towards providing extra iPads for our students.

Each lap requires students walking, jogging, or running a distance of approximately 500 metres. Students may complete a maximum of 10 recorded laps, in the time allocated. Additional time will be allowed if deemed necessary. Students with disabilities or impairments that affect their ability to complete the distance will have modified laps.

Please collect as many sponsors as possible before the day, and return your sheet and donations to school by Friday the 13th of October. Children should be accompanied by an adult when collecting sponsors and money. Each student will be given a card that will require a special stamp/signature for each lap. Each class will have a different stamping area to avoid congestion and confusion at the completion of each lap.

Sponsors may choose to donate a total amount, or an amount for each lap completed. Cheques should be made payable to Woodlands Primary School. Money must be collected and returned by Friday 13th of October if you wish to be in the running for a prize. Individual prizes will be awarded as follows:
