Wow, another year goes by which means the one and only Woodlands Performing Arts Showcase appears again.

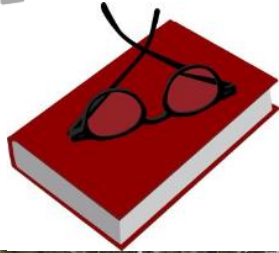
