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ROUND 2 2020 BACK TO SCHOOL ORDER INFORMATION

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR HOME ADDRESS IS UP TO DATE <u>BEFORE</u> ORDERING YOUR BACK TO SCHOOL ITEMS.

IF YOUR ADDRESS IS NOT UP TO DATE AND YOUR ORDER IS DELIVERED TO YOUR OLD ADDRESS YOUR OPTIONS ARE:

a. Go to previous address and collect package.

- b. Email the school to at woodlands.ps@edumail.vic.gov.au update your address, then re-order and pay for a new pack.
 - ALTERNATE ADDRESS If you would like your package delivered to an alternate address (Eg. Work, family member, friend). Please email the school stating your name, child/rens name and the alternate address you would like your package sent to, **prior to placing your order**. woodlands.ps@edumail.vic.gov.au
 - **DELIVERY** Orders **MUST** be finalised and payed in full by **Friday 22nd November (Unless payment plan has been selected)**.

The first order run has been processed and the 2nd run will be Monday 25th November. This is to alleviate the issues from last year with back orders. From December onwards it gets harder and harder for distributions companies to keep up with demand as this is the peak time for school ordering, so all stationary suppliers are effected with their supplies.

Your delivery should arrive within 14 - 21 days after order run, but please keep in mind this is a very busy distribution delivery time.

Your 2020 BTS information and payment options are now available on Compass through Events. You should have a Green Event banner at the top of your news feed to click on. (An email was also sent to all families on the Round 2 list).

PAYMENT PLAN OPTION - The payment plan option is as follows:

Friday 1st November - 50%

Friday 15th November - 25%

Friday 29th November - 25%

This option can be selected under the heading "Alternative Payment Method" and selecting "Pay for this event via Payment Plan". This will then show you the amount in \$ for each payment. Then proceed to 'Pay' in the green tab at the bottom of the screen.

SOURCING OWN STATIONARY PACK - This can be a very difficult and expensive exercise, you must source the exact items listed on the stationary list otherwise any other item will be sent back home. The teachers have taken a lot of time to select these items for many reasons (Eg. Some items last longer and are more robust etc.) The pricing we have is very competitive and we highly recommend purchasing the stationary pack through the school rather than sourcing your own.

However if you wish to source your own stationary pack please notify the office so we can take off the Stationary Pack amount of your 2020 BTS and you can also collect an itemised list from the office.

MAGNET Project: PULLING TOGETHER TO SUPPORT OUR CHILDREN'S FUTURES

Healthy, typically developing children

We are looking for 400 typical, healthy children from across Victoria to take part. It is vital that we understand how development of typical children is different from children with ASD or ADHD to help research the underlying causes and improve diagnosis of ASD and ADHD.

What's involved: One 4 hour research visit. Parents complete a 2-3 hour online questionnaire. Your child will complete 3-4 hours of computer based and play tasks + saliva sample.

Children diagnosed with ADHD or ASD

To improve diagnosis of ADHD and ASD, we need to capture the wide range of behaviour and development across the entire spectrum. We are looking for families who have a child with ADHD or ASD to take part.

What's involved: Two 3 hour research visits. Your child will complete 4-6 hours of computer and play-based tasks (including cognitive assessment if not current/previously done) + saliva sample. Parents complete a 3 hour online questionnaire + saliva sample.
