

Frequently Asked Questions

If I live outside of the Woodlands zone can I submit an application for my child to attend?

Absolutely. Each year we accept a large number of students from outside our enrolment boundary. Although preference is given to families who live inside our zone and those who currently have siblings at Woodlands, we still accept a large percentage of Foundation enrolments from families residing in other areas.

What information do I need to submit with my enrolment form?

To process your child's enrolment, we need a copy of the completed <u>enrolment form</u>, a copy of your child's birth certificate, a current Immunisation History statement and a proof of residence document (in zone enrolments only).

When will I find out if my child has been accepted into Woodlands for 2021?

We will begin sending out acceptance letters from August 10 for siblings and in-zone families. By early to mid-September out of zone families will receive information confirming if their child has been accepted. If you haven't heard from us by mid-September please call the Office.

What student wellbeing programs and procedures does Woodlands have in place to support students?

Woodlands employs a psychologist to oversee its wellbeing programs and procedures. This person, along with your child's classroom teacher, will work with you to support your child.

What is the best way to return the enrolment form and required information?

There are three ways you are able to submit your enrolment documentation:

- 1. Scan and email all relevant information to <u>woodlands.ps@edumail.vic.gov.au</u> (preferred)

- 3. Drop the required documentation into the school office in a named envelope.

You will receive an email confirming receipt of the enrolment form.
