## REMINDER - STAGGERED START AND FINISH TIMES

All staff will be on yard duty every morning from 8.40am (wearing fluoro yard duty vests) to assist students in getting to their classrooms. Parents will need to leave students at the school gate.

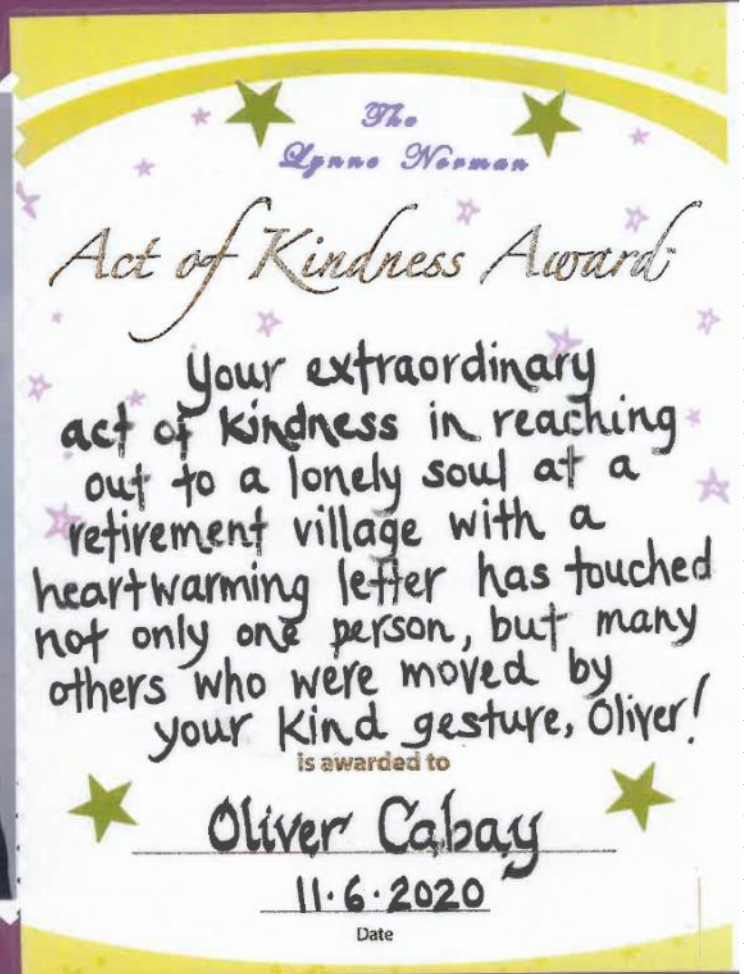
