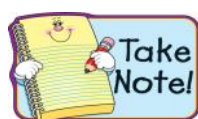

Students learned to draw the outline of a cake with a slice removed from the centre using a grey lead pencil.

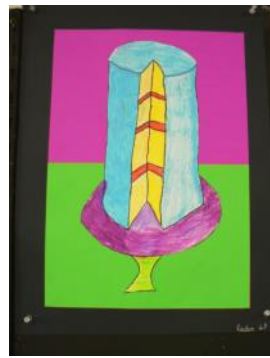
They then outlined in black sharpie pen before colouring and shading the cake using Portfolio Oil Pastels. Students used several techniques including

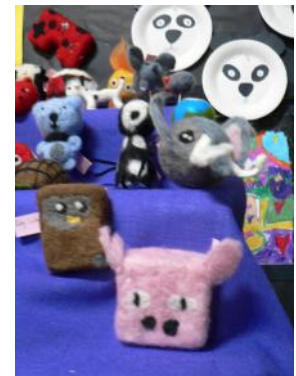
# WOODLANDS ART

Well done Grade 6. They are brilliant!

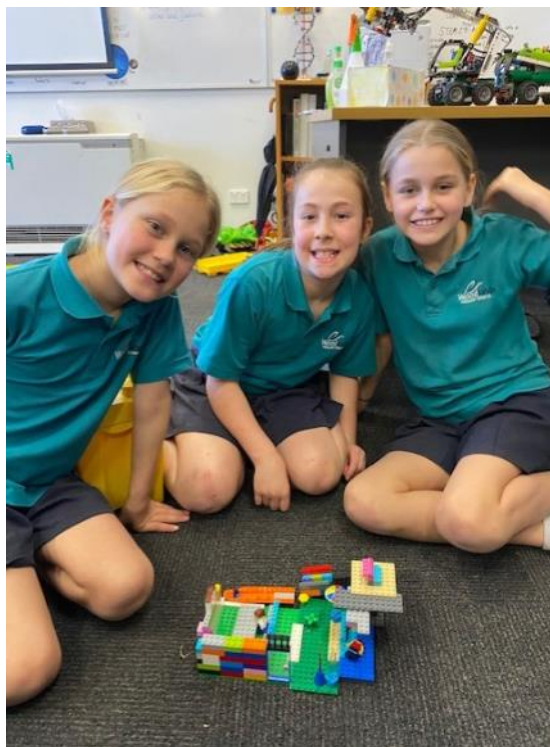
