Year 6 Event Report: Virtual Speakers Tour

On the 28th of August, the year 6's along with other schools participated in the 'Speakers Tour'. We had a visit by Hugh Williams. He spoke about how he worked at Google, Microsoft, and eBay. Google is the most popular website on the internet, while eBay is the 7th most popular. It was interesting to hear Hugh Williams' story. Hugh helped make the Google search engine. There are giant data centres for the search engines with thousands of computers.



He helped create Bing (formerly known as windows live) as well as making infinite scroll, too.

Here are the steps Google uses to make a search page:

STEP 1:

Google makes a copy of websites for whatever search you put into the search bar, then builds up a list of websites for you. Imagine filling up an entire soccer field full of computers! That's how many it takes to make Google. And it's not just ONE soccer field full of them, it takes many around the world!

STEP 2:

Google takes all of those websites, and turns them into an index, like you would find in the back of a book. The Google search engine is basically like a big book for you to search in.

STEP 3:

Google then ranks the most popular searches and matches them to your search. It uses all of those massive computer banks to make the perfect search engine.

Google has made many other things too, one of which is a small Volkswagen that is actually a meeting room. Artificial intelligence, or AI, will allow you to talk to almost any household item in the future, and the item will answer back! Now - EVERYTHING uses code, which is why you have to know how to code to be in Google. On eBay, it is not so easy to get what you want, as there are too many products being sold by so many people, that there will be hundreds, if not thousands of items to match your search. Whenever you use amazon, google, eBay, or anything like that, they test you, experiment you, and get the most popular results for people. We really enjoyed it, as I am sure everyone else did, and Oscar and I are looking forward to the next one too.
