#### **2022 BACK TO SCHOOL PACKS**

We had such a successful BTS process last year we will once again be using KAKA Kids as our 2022 BTS supplier.



However, the ordering process is a little different.

This year we invite you to order your 2022 BTS packs directly through KA KA Kids via the website.

You will find on Compass, each year level itemised BTS list with instructions on how to order and also a FAQ's document.

### **PLEASE NOTE:**

- · OWhen ordering online, it will ask you for your address. This is a stipulation for the payment portal. However, your order will still be sent directly to the school.
- · Prior to ordering packs for 2022 Year 1 to 6 online, you will need your child/ren's individual student ID (Not the family ID). This can be found by clicking on your child's photo in the Compass app. If you have a 2022 Foundation student you will not need the student ID.
- $\cdot$  Any orders placed after December the 1st will incur a fee of \$14.95
- · Pack Items and quantities cannot be changed.
- · Please also read the '2022 BTS Pack FAQ's' document for more information, you will find this on Compass.

## Canteen on-line ordering/I.O.U's /Credits/forgotten lunches

Just a reminder that canteen on line ordering is through My School Connect and has been since March this year.

You can download their app or use the website to order www.MySchoolConnect.com.au

### **ALL ORDERS MUST BE IN BY 8.30am ON THE DAY OF THE ORDER REQUIRED**

Families who miss the 8.30 am cut off will need to organise their child's lunch themselves. The app will not let you process lunch orders after the cut off time. If you do not receive a confirmation email then your order was not successfully placed.

For any families who still have credit with MKLB (My Kids Lunchbox), This money can no longer be refunded by the canteen. The cut-off date to organise this was back in April. You will need to organise your refund with MKLB.

## The Canteen will no longer be taking IOU's for lunch orders.

This is due to having to chase and follow up monies owed.

PLEASE NOTE: For special circumstances such us student leaving lunch at home and families unable to organise lunch to be sent in by someone, the offer of a Jam or Vegemite sandwich for \$3.00 will be available. To be paid by the end of the day.

If you forget to put money in your lunch order bag/envelope you will be contacted to organise lunch to be dropped off for your child **or** the money for your child's lunch order be dropped off the same day **prior to 1pm**, then your child will receive their lunch order.

## Support for your kids to get active

Does your child love sport and being active? Does your family have a Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card? You may be eligible for up to \$200 to put towards the cost of your child's participation in physical activities.

As children return to sport over the coming months, the Get Active Kids Voucher Program helps eligible families get their kids involved in organised sport and active recreation activities.

Under the program, children may be eligible to receive up to \$200 to help with the cost of membership and registration fees, uniforms, and equipment.

The program also provides a special consideration stream to support children residing in care services as well as temporary or provisional visa holders, undocumented migrants or international students.

Applications for vouchers in round three of the program close at 5pm Tuesday 30 November.


