


Dear Parents and Guardians,

Thank you so much for supporting our school in these last few interrupted years of learning. This term, we are hosting a **Colour Explosion School Fun Run** to help us fundraise for updating our basketball area precinct. To achieve our goal, we aim to raise \$30,000 as a school community. The school has already commenced the update over Summer with the refurbishment of the amphitheatre around the perimeter of the basketball court.

When is the Colour Explosion School Fun Run? We will be hosting our Colour Explosion School Fun Run on Friday April 1st. Students will be able to order a WPS Colour Run T-Shirt or bring their own WHITE shirt to wear during the Fun Run. They will be covered in non-toxic, biodegradable colour powder from head to toe!

How does my child fundraise? Fundraising for the update of our Basketball Area precinct is easy – simply follow the instructions outlined in your child's sponsorship booklet. Your child can accept donations online by creating a cybersafe fundraising profile at www.australianfundraising.com.au. The school will not be collecting any cash payments for our fundraising. Please complete your donations by Friday the 1st of April.

Colour Run T-Shirts

We have two options.

Add your Billing Details and select local pick up.

To the right of the screen in Order Notes, add only one of your CHILDS GRADES as all your families T-shirts will be bundled together for that child to take home.



2022 CSEF

Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund applications

The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you have a **valid** means-tested concession card, such as a Veterans Affairs Gold Card, Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible. There is also a special consideration category for asylum seeker and refugee families.

Payment amounts this year are \$125 for eligible primary school students. Payments are made direct to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions and sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

It is important that funding made available in 2022 supports students to participate in school trips, camps and sporting activities this year rather than being held for future years. This funding can also be used in conjunction with any funding accrued from previous years. Please note these activities will only take place if they meet COVIDSafe requirements.

HOW TO APPLY

FAMILIES WHO APPLIED LAST YEAR

- If you applied for CSEF through our school last year and have a Foundation child start this year, then you will need to fill out an application form and attach a copy of your Healthcare Card.
- If you applied for CSEF through our school last year and have no new children begin this year you will need to either email or bring in your Healthcare card to be copied.

FAMILIES WHO HAVE NEVER APPLIED AND ARE ELIGIBLE

If you would like to apply for the first time, please either print the form attached to this post or come into the office to collect a hard copy.

You can also download the form, and find out more about the program and eligibility, on the Department of Education and Training's Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund web page.

Check with the school office if you are unsure, and please return completed forms to the school office **as soon as possible**.
