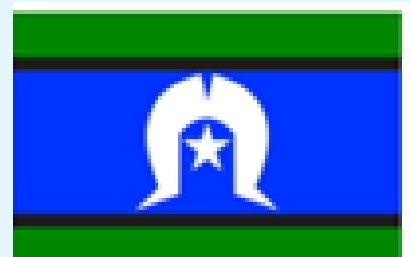
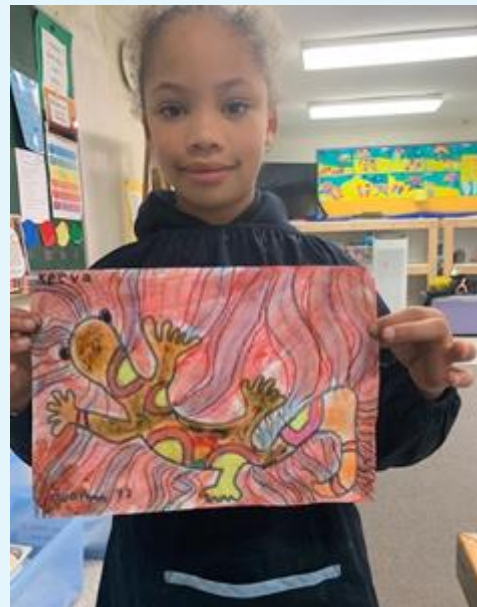


NAIDOC WEEK
